► Replacement animals must be certified grass fed unless “commercially unavailable”. Complete this form as needed to show commercial unavailability for certified grass fed animals per Organic Plus Trust (OPT) Program Manual XI.B and OPT Dairy Standards section III. When certified grass fed animals are commercially unavailable, certified organic animals may be sourced provided this form is completed, the office notified and a plan to segregate the organic animal’s milk for 90-days is implemented.

► Certified Grass Fed Animals must be certified to the OPT Grass Fed Organic Livestock Program. For 2019 animals may also be certified to equivalent programs: *NOFA-NY 100% Grass Fed*, *PCO 100% Grass Fed*, *VOF 100% Grass Fed*.

A grass-fed organic dairy animal is **commercially unavailable** for purchase whenever an operation certified to the OPT Standard demonstrates to the certifying agent that it cannot timely obtain an animal with the operation’s animal attributes. **Operation’s animal attributes** may include but is not limited to, breed, age, health, replacement transport time, body score, disease/illness profile, source location, performance history, etc.
