In accordance with the 2018 Farm Bill, hemp and its derivatives may be certified as organic, if produced in accordance with USDA National Organic Program (NOP) organic regulations.

The term 'hemp' means the plant Cannabis sativa L. and any part of that plant, including the seeds thereof and all derivatives, extracts, cannabinoids, isomers, acids, salts, and salts of isomers, whether growing or not, with a delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol concentration of not more than 0.3 percent on a dry weight basis.

Hemp may be certified to the USDA National Organic Program standards (NOP). Operations wishing to certify should be in compliance with the 2018 Farm Bill and their state authority governing hemp production/processing.

As new guidance and regulatory clarifications are released from the USDA, NOP or applicable state regulatory agencies regarding the production and processing of hemp, NOFA-NY policy on organic certification of hemp is subject to change.

By signing this document you understand that NOFA-NY Certified Organic LLC is verifying your operation to the NOP. Other applicable federal and state laws are your responsibility as the grower/processor and organic certification does not represent compliance to any regulation other than the NOP.
