Any dual-use* equipment or storage areas that could have non-organic crop residue must be thoroughly cleaned prior to organic use. **Examples: planting & harvesting equipment, hay mows, grain bins, silos, drying/roasting equipment, wagons/truck beds, etc.** Note: Some equipment (square balers, combines, etc.) will require a purge of organic crops after non-organic use. The purge is considered non-organic. *New Applicants: cleanout of equipment/storage areas prior to beginning organic production for the first time should also be documented here.*

* Dual-use is defined as being used for both organic and non-organic; non-organic includes transitional, conventional, and buffer crop use

If you have your standard operating procedures (SOPs) listed in your Organic System Plan (OSP) for cleaning dual-use equipment and storage, you do not need to submit this form to us annually. You may retain for your own use as needed. This form is only required to be submitted when documenting the cleaning/purging of dual-use equipment and storage areas **NOT** listed in your OSP or when your cleaning procedures have varied from your usual SOPs.

Use this key to help document the cleaning procedures: **W-Washed; PW-Power Washed; B-Brushed; S-Swept; A-Air blown; F-Flushed; V-Vacuumed; P-Purged; O-Other (be specific).** Documentation of cleanout must be available to the inspector as part of your audit trail, either in your OSP or separate log.
