Farmers who seek guidance in evaluating their production practices and assistance with their certification application are encouraged to apply. Participating farmers receive the following services:

- Farm visits by the Organic Transition Educator to discuss organic production practices, review certification application information and answer questions about materials or equipment
- Ongoing support from the Organic Transitions Educator via video conference, phone or email
- Technical assistance from NOFA-NY education staff who specialize in specific crops or livestock
- On-farm field days, webinars and workshops to facilitate farmer-to-farmer learning opportunities and address organic production challenges
- Collaborative mentorship from the NOFA-NY Farmer-to-Farmer Mentor Team
